Breaking Generational Sins and Curses!!!

Every living person is part of a family whether we are close to our families or not or whether we even know our families or not. It doesn't change the fact that if you are alive you came from somewhere; you had parents.

You had grandparents' aunts and uncles, cousins and siblings so like it or not and being a part of a family unit comes with many blessings it comes with things like unconditional love and support it comes with structure and empathy and compassion. However, for someone else being part of a family can bring unwanted things into your life. Certain families come with baggage, other families come with a lack of structure or a lack of love. Sometimes being a part of a family comes with curses. Being genetically tied to a family means that there are certain genetic dispositions that will be written in your DNA. Health histories like heart disease, diabetes, high blood pressure, alcoholism, drug addiction, and mental health disorders have all been proven to be genetically transferable from one generation to the next.

What are generational sins and curses? What does the Bible say about them.

Iniquity= perversity, depravity, iniquity, guilt or punishment of iniquity

- A. Iniquity = guilt of iniquity, guilt (as great), guilt (of condition)
- B. consequence of or punishment for iniquity
- C. perversity, i.e. (moral) evil:—fault, iniquity, mischief, punishment (of iniquity), sin.

Exodus 20:5 NLT ⁵ You must not bow down to them or worship them, for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods. I lay the sins of the parents upon their children; the entire family is affected—even children in the third and fourth generations of those who reject me. ⁶ But I lavish unfailing love for a thousand generations on those ^[a] who love me and obey my commands.

Exodus 20:5. The Voice ⁵ You are not to **bow down** and serve any image, for I, the Eternal your God, am a jealous God. As for those who are not loyal to Me, **their**

children will endure the consequences of their sins for three or four generations. ⁶ But for those who love Me and keep My directives, their children will experience My loyal love for a thousand generations.

Exodus 20:5-6 The Message⁴⁻⁶ No carved gods of any size, shape, or form of anything whatever, whether of things that fly or walk or swim. Don't bow down to them and don't serve them **because / am God**, your God, and I'm a most jealous God, punishing the children for any sins their parents pass on to them to the third, and yes, even to the fourth generation of those who hate me. But I'm unswervingly loyal to the thousands who love me and keep my commandments.

Exodus 34:7. The Voice ⁷ who maintains loyal love to thousands *of people*, who forgives wrongdoing, rebellion, and sin; yet does not allow sin to go unpunished, extending the consequences of a father's sin to his children, his grandchildren, and even to the third and fourth generations.

Deuteronomy 5:9-10 The Voice ⁹ You are not to bow down in worship of any images of other gods, for I am the Eternal your God. I am jealous for worship, bringing punishment on you and your children to come, even down to your great-grandchildren, to whoever hates Me. 10 Instead those who obey My commands and truly love Me will receive My loyal love endlessly, even for a thousand generations.

Nehemiah 9:2 gives us the pattern to receive our freedom from these curses.

Nehemiah 9:2 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition ² And the Israelites separated themselves from all foreigners and stood and **confessed their sins** and the iniquities of their fathers.

The Good News is that Galatians 3:13 The Voice¹³ the Anointed One, the Liberating King, has redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us. It was stated in the Scriptures, "Everyone who hangs on a tree is cursed by God."

A generational curse is the cumulative effect on a person of things that their ancestors did, believed, or practiced in the past. Some common examples of generational curses include:

Sin & trouble passing from generation to generation is a continual theme throughout the Old Testament. Tonight, we will look at the 3 ways in which we may come under defilement of generational sin. We may: 1. inherit our propensities to sin through our genes, 2. through example and 3. through the power of the law of judging and receiving. By the AUTHORITY given to us in Christ Jesus, we are able to break the bonds of generational sin. Through prayer we can help to free families from its PATTERNS of Destruction.

Definition of Generational Sin: the effects and consequences of sin on subsequent generations. **Violence, Generational trauma, Addiction, Codependency, Hoarding, Poverty mindset, Single parenthood, and Dying young.**

[Psalm 51:5 KJV] 5 Behold, I was shapen [H2342] in iniquity; [H5771] and in sin [H2399] did my mother[H517] conceive[H3179] me. He confesses his original corruption (v. 5): Behold, I was shapen in iniquity.

"but let me consider it rather as an aggravation of the sin: Lord, I have not only been guilty of adultery and murder, but I have an adulterous murderous nature. Lord, I therefore abhor myself."

Note, It is to be sadly lamented by every one of us that we brought into the world with us a **corrupt nature**, wretchedly degenerated from its primitive purity and rectitude; we have from our birth the snares of sin in our bodies, the seeds of sin in our souls, and a stain of sin upon both. This is what we call **original sin**, because it is as ancient as our original, and because it is the original of all our actual transgressions. It is a bent/propensity to backslide from God.

[Isaiah 44:22 KJV] 22 I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee.

...how to bring healing from generational sin

cherish your heritage	
recognition — to see and name a thing is to begin to have power over it	
 help trace the history of the family, watching for distinct, recurrent patterns 	
 build a family tree 	
use a Life History form	
 ask Holy Spirit for understanding 	
confession — lead counselee to confess the truth of the situation and acknowledge participation in the sin	
repentance	
 the Bible says a righteous son will not inherit the father's iniquity Jeremiah 31:29-30; Ezekiel 18:17 	
• it also says no one is righteou s Psalm 14, Romans 3:10-18 thus we must depend on the cross to stop the trouble	
repent for ancestors (this is biblical)repent for self	
forgiveness — lead counselee to forgive ancestors, and affirm that Christ forgives them for their participation in the sin	
prayer — place the cross between generations so the sins of the ancestors are stopped there; claim and believe this	
 pray about each specific descending pattern—divorce, cancer, alcoholism homosexuality, etc.— reckon it as dead on the cross Proverbs 20:7; 13:22; Psalm 103:17-18; Isaiah 54:13

- when there has been occult involvement pray a "hiding prayer"
 - although our lives are normally "hidden in Christ," Colossians 3:3 occult involvement exposes us to the sight of the enemy
- pray for release by destruction
 - "...The Son of God appeared for this purpose, that He might destroy the works of the devil." IJohn 3:8 NAS
- - "familiar spirits"
- pray that God will bless the family and celebrate in faith that it will be so
- continue in prayer and intercession
 Romans 2:4-7; 12:12; Acts 12:5; Ephesians 6:18; James 5:13-20
