- 4 Ask God to cleanse w/the blood of Jesus all who were defiled by the bitter root judgments.
- 5 Renounce the inner vow that I would never do what they did. A) I'll never show favorites like Mom. B) I'll never embarrass my child in public like Mom did me.
- 6 Break any ungodly soul tie between self & Mom.







